1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Jewels International (JI) Chetana College of Special Education, Bhubaneswar, has been established by Jewels International, Registered under Society Registration Act No. XXI, of 1860 in Odisha. The main objective of the College is to undertake Manpower Development, and provide service to persons with Intellectual Disability and other disabled persons. As a part of the Training Programmes, Chetana College offers two Academic year Teachers Training Course leading to Diploma in Education Special Education (Intellectual Disability & Developmental Disorder) and B. Ed.in Special Education (Intellectual Disability).

The course prepares the students to work as Special Educators in Special School for students with Intellectual Disability (ID), work as teacher in Inclusive Schools, in medical set up as professional, and also to work as teacher in general school in various level after qualifying OTET and CBT.

The JI Chetana College of Special Education, Bhubaneswar, has been recognized by Social Security & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (SSEPD) Department, Govt. of Odisha approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India, a Statutory Body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, New Delhi and Affiliated to Utkal University, Bhubaneswar.

2.0 OBJECTIVES

To prepare teachers who can perform the following after completion of the course: -

- To perceive the so called 'Disabled' as 'Differently Abled' and develop in them the confidence about their potentialities, abilities and usefulness to serve the society with a sense of freedom, self-respect and dignity.
- To develop professional competencies to educate persons with Intellectual Disability & Developmental Disorders.
- To know and understand various methods and approaches of organizing education of children with Intellectual Disability & Developmental Disorders under inclusive, integrated and special education set up.
- To understand the nature of children with Intellectual Disability & Developmental Disorders in the learning process.
- To develop competencies to deal with the academic and personal problems of the learners with Intellectual Disability & Developmental Disorders.
- To know and understand the various methods and techniques of evaluation and their applications.
- To develop competencies to organize various co-curricular and extracurricular activities.
- To know, understand and develop the ability to manage a Special School as well as general school.

3.0 ELIGIBILITY

The candidate must fulfill the eligibility conditions given below:

The candidate must have passed B. A / B.Sc./B. Com or an equivalent degree at graduate level with equivalent to Utkal University with a minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate in case of General candidates and 45% of marks in aggregate in case of SC, ST, PWDs, OBC and SEBC candidates.

Or

The candidate must have passed in the Master's degree in Sciences/ Social Sciences/ Humanities, with a minimum of 55% of marks in aggregate in case of General candidates and 50% of marks in aggregate in case of SC, ST, PWDs, OBC and SEBC candidates.

Or

Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55 % marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.

3.1 No age bar for this course.

3.2 Caste Certificate

In case of SC, ST and OBC / SEBC candidates, the Caste Certificate should be issued by the concerned Tahasildar / Additional Tahasildar. The Caste Certificate shall be considered by virtue of birth only not by marriage or adoption.

3.3 The candidates are required to submit PWD Certificate issued in their favour in the prescribed form by Medical Board countersigned by CDMO concerned. (Reservation under PWD category is for candidates with mild disability in one lower/upper limb only).

4.0 DURATION

The B.Ed. Special Education (ID) Programme shall be of two-year duration covering two consecutive academic Session

5.0 SEATS

There shall be 30 seats available for the Course.

5.1 SC & ST: 16% of the seats for the SC and 23% for ST. In case of non-availability of candidates in one of these categories, seats will be filled up from the candidates of the General Category. (SC-5 seats, ST-6 seats)

5.2 Orthopedically Handicapped: 5% of the total number of seats will be reserved for Orthopedically Handicapped candidates. In case of non-availability, the seats will be filled up from the general category. (2 seat)

5.3 OBC/SEBC: 11% of the seats will be reserved for OBC/SEBC candidates. In case of non-availability of candidates, seats will be filled up from the candidates of the General Category (3 seats).

5.4 50% of the seats will be reserved for general candidates. (15 Seats)

5.5 In-Service: 15% of the seats are reserved for In-Service candidates. Two seats from SC/ ST quota and two seats from General quota. In case of non-availability of SC/ ST and General category, the seats will be filled up from OBC/SEBC category.

5.6 Untrained In-service Teachers working in Special School for ID, registered under RPWD Act, 2016 are eligible to be considered under In-service quota. He/ she must have completed at least one year of continuous service by the date of submission of Application Form.

6.0 SELECTION

The selection will be made as per Career marking.

This is a full-time course of two academic year; the candidates admitted to the Course can't pursue any other course. Selected candidates should join the course by the stipulated date after attending Counselling session.

At the time of joining the course, the selected candidate will deposit their original certificates for verification which will be released after 3 months from the date of admission. If necessary, he/she may take the certificates by submitting the certificate deposit receipt along with application in case of emergency only.

50% or above but less than 59% : 2nd Division

60% or above less than 69% : 1st Division

70% and above : 1st Division with Distinction

15.0 AWARD OF DEGREE

The University shall award the Degree "Bachelor of Education Special Education (Intellectual Disability)" to the successful candidates

16.0 TRANSITORY REGULATIONS

Whenever a course or scheme of instruction is changed in a particular year, two more examinations immediately following thereafter shall be conducted according to the old syllabus/ regulations. Candidates not appearing at the examinations or failing shall take the examinations subsequently according to the changed syllabus/ regulations/ as per university norms.
